William Davis introduced the VP for Frontier Waste, Bill Killean, and informed that Absolute Waste had sold the company to Frontier Waste with no changes to the existing contract. They asked that the City accept the assignment letter from Frontier Waste. Councilman Vasquez motioned, seconded by Councilman Keeney, to sign the contract assignment letter from Absolute Waste Services to Frontier Waste with the City of Taft.

Mr. Rich Silva, CenterPoint Energy reported on the 2023 Grip Adjustment for the South Texas Division affecting the Taft customer rate to an increase from \$27.02 per month to \$30.75 per month, an increase of \$3.72. It would take effect May 1, 2023, unless suspended by Council. Suspension would delay the adjusted rate effective date to June 1, 2023. Mayor Powell motioned, seconded by Councilman Vasquez, to suspend the GRIP Adjustment for the South Texas Division.
