- 3. VISITORS At this time, comments will be taken from the audience on any subject matter. To address the Council, please sign the Opinion/Speaker Registration Form located on the table at the entrance of the meeting room and deliver to the City Secretary before the meeting begins. Should there be more than five (5) people who wish to speak on a particular issue they need to select one (1) representative to speak for them. In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council may not discuss or take action on any item which has not been posted on the agenda. Citizens are to refrain from any personal attacks on the council or any member of the staff. Failure to abide by these policies could result in a charge of disorderly conduct.
- 4. Consider, discuss, and take action to adopt Ordinance No. 1071, an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 968 and rescinding Ordinance No. 984, to designate that the Chief of Police be a municipal officer appointed, hired, and removed by the City's governing body.
- 5. Consider, discuss and take action to approve Ordinance No. 1072, an emergency ordinance of the City of Taft, Texas extending a local state of disaster declaration due to a public health emergency known as severe winter weather for ninety (90) calendar days from date of ordinance.

- 4. Texas Open Meetings Act **Personnel matters** involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee.
- 5. Texas Open Meetings Act The deployment or specific occasion for the implementation of Section 551.076 security personnel or devices.
- Texas Open Meetings Act Deliberations regarding economic development negotiations.
