Should there be more than five (5) people who wish to speak on a particular issue they need to select one (1) representative to speak for them. In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council may not discuss or take action on any item which has not been posted on the agenda. Citizens are to refrain from any personal attacks on the council or any member of the staff. Failure to abide by these policies could result in a charge of disorderly conduct.
- 4. Consider, discuss and take action to approve the April 9, 2019 regular meeting minutes, May 14, 2019 regular meeting minutes, May 19, 2019 special meeting minutes, and May 28, 2019 regular meeting minutes.
- 5. Consider and discuss update regarding the city's financial condition as it relates to bonded debt, past dues, recurring payments, revenues and expenditures.
- 6. Consider, discuss and take action to approve a Joint Election contract between the City and San Patricio County Election Administrator for the County to conduct the City's General Election for Tuesday, November 5, 2019.
- 7. Consider, discuss and take action to approve Ordinance No. 1038, an ordinance of the City of Taft, Texas calling and ordering a general election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 for the purpose of electing one Mayor At-Large, one Alderman for Ward One and one Alderman for Ward Two.

Consider, discuss and take action to approve Ordinance No. 1039, an ordinance of the City of Taft, Texas calling and ordering a special elections to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 for the purpose of adopting a five dollar (\$5.00) monthly fee per utility residential account and a ten dollar (\$10.00) monthly fee per utility commercial account located within the city limits of the City of Taft, Texas, to provide for new streets, street repair, and street maintenance to be imposed for five years.
