In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council may not discuss or take action on any item which has not been posted on the agenda. Citizens are to refrain from any personal attacks on the council or any member of the staff. Failure to abide by these policies could result in a charge of disorderly conduct.
- 4. Consider and discuss update regarding the city's financial condition as it relates to bonded debt, past dues, recurring payments, revenues and expenditures.
- 5. Consider, discuss, and take action to approve Resolution 617, a resolution regarding a finance contract for the purpose of procuring police vehicles.
- 6. Consider, discuss, and take action to approve an interlocal agreement with San Patricio County Department of Health in regards to animal control.
- 7. Discuss, consider, and act to amend the compensation scale by removing the wording "and City Council."
- 8. 	4.	Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.074	<b>Personnel matters</b> involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee.
	5.	Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.076	The deployment or specific occasion for the implementation of security personnel or devices.
	6.	Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.087	Deliberations regarding economic development negotiations.
