The project consists of installing (4) Four Generators (City Hall, Community Center, Police Department and Water Treatment Plant), ATS (Automatic Transfer Switchovers), Generator Concrete Pads (Meeting TDI Windstorm Requirements), and all necessary electrical/controls meeting all Federal, State, & Local Codes & Regulations in accordance with the contract documents, technical specifications, and plans.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing Davis-Bacon and Related Acts wage rate, as issued by the Department of Labor and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project.
